

CONSTRUCTION COMMENCES ON STAGE 2 LITHIUM HYDROXIDE PROCESSING PLANT

Tianqi Lithium Australia and MSP Engineering are pleased to announce that construction work for stage 2 of the lithium hydroxide processing plant (LHPP2) in Kwinana has officially commenced.

Tianqi Lithium Australia gave the green light to develop LHPP2 in October this year.

Valued at approximately \$300 million, the project has already committed over \$50 million in long-lead orders. Local content will exceed 80 percent.

Stage 2 will add 200 construction jobs to the project with an overall workforce expected to peak at 500.

LHPP2 is scheduled for commissioning towards the end of 2019. Once complete the Kwinana plant will have a capacity of 48,000 tonnes per annum of high purity, battery-grade lithium hydroxide.

This will make the Kwinana plant the world's largest lithium hydroxide producer.
